Intensive Case Management

In this program children are monitored in various ways to help recovery. They include:

- Home-based individual and family counseling
- Coordination with the child's school
- Crisis intervention
- Case management services
- Advocacy

On-Site School Programming

On-site school programming is offered in the LaPorte Community School Corporation, Michigan City Area Schools and the New Prairie United School Corporation. Each school participating in the program receives services developed to meet the needs of their specific student population. Services may include:

- Case Management
- Individual, Family and Group Therapy
- Skills Training and Development
- Crisis Intervention

Through a variety of services, children and adolescents learn how to improve their school performance, develop decision making and problem solving skills, increase positive peer and adult interactions and learn new skills for managing their emotions. Parent involvement is a necessary component of all on-site school services. The collaboration between the school, Swanson Center staff and parents or guardians encourages success at home, in school and in the community.
